Minutes – CNYOS Meeting
May 7, 2006

Judi Wilkins opened the business portion of the meeting by announcing that the CNYOS displays at the STOS (Southern Tier Orchid Society) show did very well and garnered many awards. The awards will be listed in the CNYOS Newsletter but Judi thanked everyone for their participation and help. Our club had a great show!

1. Carol Haskell presented the Treasurer's report; the club has a balance of \$4,619.35 to date. Judy reminded everyone that current club dues are now officially overdue.
2. Judi announced that the Executive Committee choose Beaver Lake to donate the 1% of club income the club agreed to give to a local group to promote orchid conservation at the April meeting. Tom Lloyd said that Beaver Lake is interested in restarting their population of native orchids and would use the money for that purpose. Judi asked for volunteers to join a committee to decide how to help Beaver Lake meet this goal and sent around a sign up sheet. The committee will meet at least once this summer to set up an action plan.
3. Charles Ufford, our newsletter editor, has a new computer and needs new software to produce the newsletter. He will advise the club what software programs he needs.
4. Charles also reminded members that he has included a "trading post" listing in the newsletter for members to post plants they would like to barter for, items they are looking to get rid of or to acquire, etc. Members should contact Charles to put a listing in the CNYOS Newsletter.
5. New Business:
 - ∑ Judi announced the CNYOS 2006 Show is scheduled for the weekend of October 14-15; set up will take place on Friday, October 13. The show will be held at Beaver Lake. Volunteer sign-up sheets will be available at the September meeting and Judi asked that new members consider learning how to set up the show or create a show display. In addition, Iris Cohen said she would like a volunteer to help with preregistration. She would like to have one other member in the club who can do this job.
 - ∑ June 4 will be the annual CNYOS Picnic; it will be held at Dave Ditz's house. The rain date will be June 11. Details about time, food arrangements and directions to Dave's house will be given in the June newsletter
 - ∑ Judi announced that Jeff Stuart has a new house and any members who want to contact him can get his new address from Judi.
